GEUS ANNOUNCES FASTER INTERNET AND NEW PRICING STRUCTURE

(January 13, 2020-Greenville, Texas) GEUS continues to increase its Internet customer's available bandwidth as homes and business become more reliant on devices needing faster connectivity.

The system-wide upgrade approved by the GEUS Board late last year is now complete.

Most GEUS residential customers have seen maximum download speeds increase from 20 mbps to 250 mbps.

Some customers will see speeds as high as 450 mbps.

In addition to increased speeds, customer's monthly rates have been lowered in five of the eight residential and commercial packages.

"GEUS is very excited to be increasing speeds and lowering customer's cost at a time when the need for reliable Internet becomes increasingly more important in our homes and businesses," said GEUS General Manager Alicia Price.

GEUS became the first municipally-owned electric utility in Texas in 1891. 110 years later it became the first municipally-owned cable television and high speed Internet operation in Texas. GEUS offers these services to the 26,000 plus consumer/owners living in the Greenville, Texas area located approximately 50 miles East of Dallas, Texas. GEUS is uniquely governed by an autonomous board of trustees that is appointed by the Greenville City Council. Steps were taken by the Texas Legislature in 1989 to allow this type of governing structure.
